TAXES



Simplifies the complex nature of filing income tax returns while encouraging conformance to IRS rules and regulations. ITIN is thoroughly explained.

EMPLOYMENT



Alerts employees to their rights and responsibilities in the workplace. Federal agencies and state agencies are discussed.

HEALTHCARE



Educates immigrants about important aspects of the healthcare system, including their right to an interpreter and health insurance.

PUBLIC ASSISTANCE



Outlines assistance programs and helps cut through the red tape that often impedes the availability of benefits for low-income immigrant families.

EDUCATION



Gives families a road map to assist them in helping their children navigate the school environment. Opportunities for adult learners are mentioned.

TRANSPORTATION



Provides the "how-to" for becoming a legal driver. Step-by-step instructions are provided for using a taxi. Other topics include car registration and the consequences of driving under the influence of alcohol and other drugs.

FINANCES



Addresses the myth that putting money in the bank is an unsafe practice. Shows that everyone can open and use a bank account.

HOUSING



Explains landlord-tenant law and outlines how to become a successful renter. Provides resources for home ownership.

LEGAL SYSTEM



Introduces the USA legal system through scenarios of violations & consequences. Outlines immigrants' rights in connection with law enforcement & the justice system.

IMMIGRATION



The complex nature of the changing rules & regulations are outlined to help immigrants better understand the B.C.I.S. system, with emphasis on family migration.

Public libraries are for every person who lives in the U.S., young and old, regardless of immigration status.

How do I borrow books or other items?

You just need a library card!

A letter or piece of mail with your name and address is usually all you need to get a library card.



Will my name, address or other personal information be shared with anyone or any agency?

Library staff will never share your personal information, or even that you are in the library, with anyone.

You can borrow books or other items for a certain period of time and you can renew them if you need more time. When you're done with the items, just return the materials in good condition to the library.

Many libraries also offer reading and other educational programs for children and adults, sometimes in more than one language

Many libraries have bilingual staff, and books, CDs and other materials in multiple languages

How Can the Public Library help me and my family?

- Ⓞ Help my young child learn to read, prepare for school, or complete school assignments
- Ⓞ Help me find a job, an ESL, GED or other class, etc.
- Ⓞ Help me and my family learn to use a computer and the Internet
- Ⓞ Meet new people and make new friends
